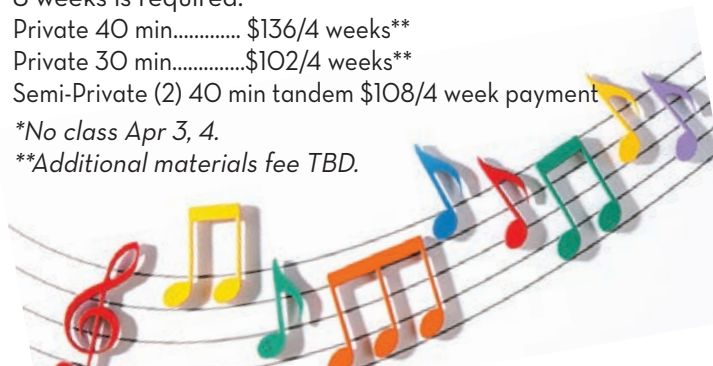

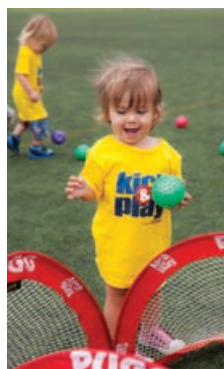

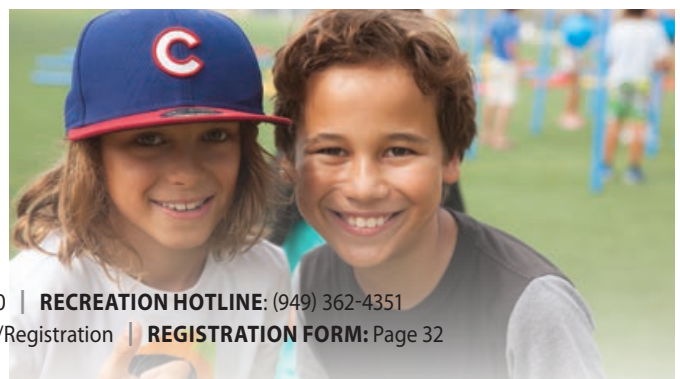
### SQUIRRELS
